State Updates

TX – Harvest activity, slow - rain. 5% harvested, slight decline in crop conditions. Lodging in Central TX region, severe weather, but close to harvest. Harvesting SW of San Antonio – Corpus Christi. Good quality. TW avg 61.5 lbs, little damage, variable protein, avg. 14.5%, some 18% and some 8%. Harvesting around Abeline area. Blacklands 1 – 2 weeks from harvest, rain/severe weather. S. Plains chopping/haying/silage. Panhandle progressing, soft dough stage. Rain/severe weather (tornado/winds/tornado) forecast next 7 days.

OK – USDA est. 96.2 mln/bu. Rains past few days, some major hail damage in N. OK. More rain forecast this week. If dry, could see harvest activity in SW OK.

CA – 60% G-E. Hearing a of crop will make grade, may see a lot of blending due to varieties. Uppers 80s/sun forecast, crop drying. Expect desert durum harvest in a few weeks. Winter wheat early June.

CO – Conditions improved. 52% G-E. NE Corner lots of rain. Cooler than avg. temps, warmer this week but mild (low 70s). Drought monitor slight improvement, still D2 in major growing in SE state. Low levels of strip rust near NE/KS border. Some mosaic virus.

Warm/dry forecast.

WY – 85% G. Wind, cooler than avg. temps. 80 degree forecast. Little jointing, est. 10 days behind avg. Est. end- July.

SD – 70% G-E for winter. Forecast yield 52 bu/ac. Some poor spring stands in wet part of state. Good position moisture wise. Crop looks good.

MN – 80-90% planted spring. 60% emerged. Rains in growing region past week.

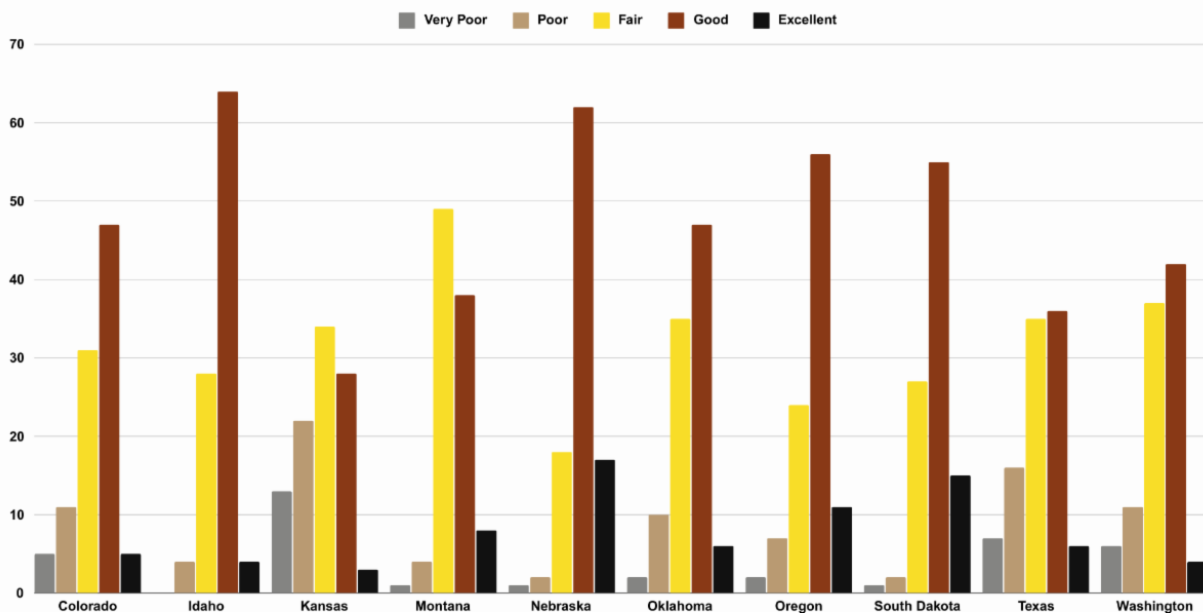
MT – Improved moisture conditions. Planting 5-10% above avg. Durum still needs planting. Showers forecast next week (40% chance). Winter conditions improved. Est. yield 47 bu/ac (slightly be 2023). Durum area still abnormally dry, showers forecast.

ID – Moisture in South great, N ID slightly drier than avg. Crop looks good, warmer temps past week/storms/wind. High winds forecast this weekend.

WA – Conditions looking good. Warmer weather past few days, cooling off. Rain still needed. Topsoil improved, subsoil no change. Winter 10-15% headed, higher elevation still jointing. Some spring planting left, but slightly ahead of avg.

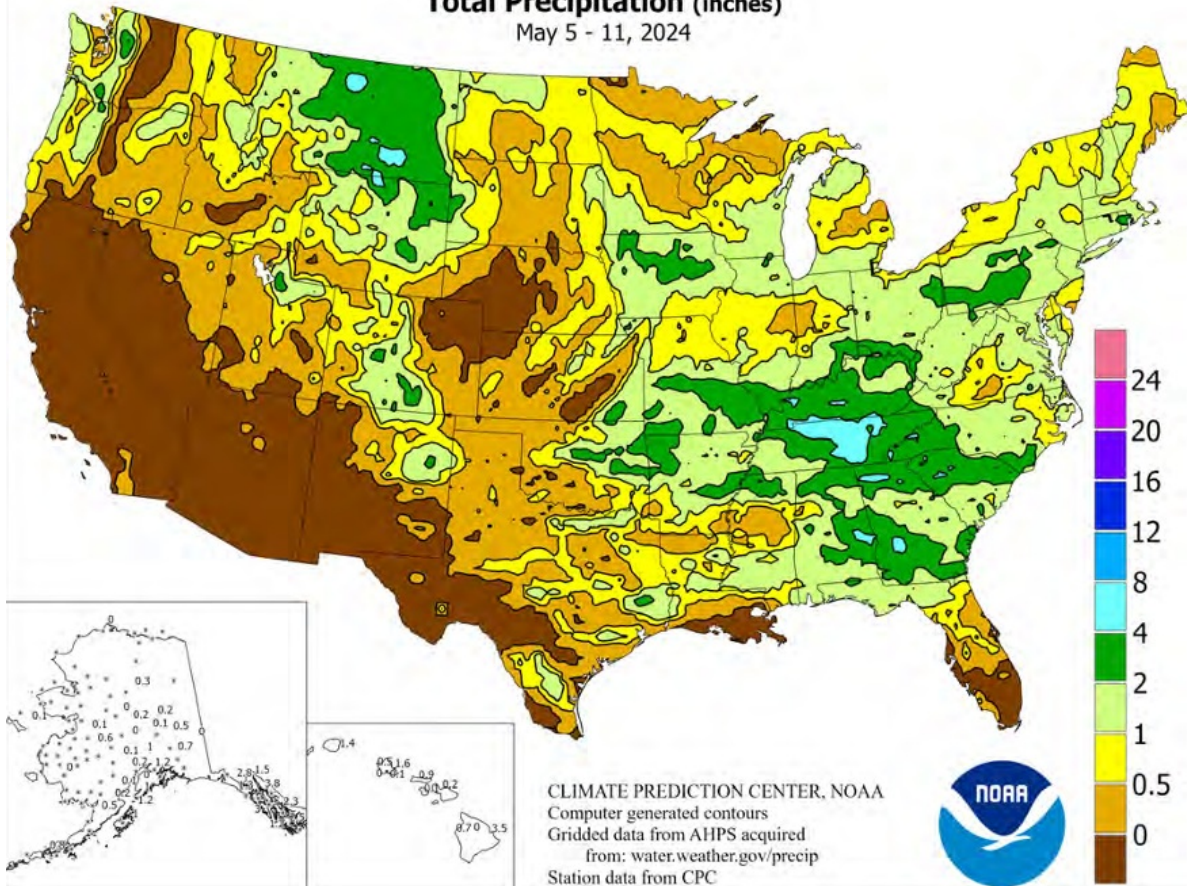
OR – Crop looks good. Warmer weather, but cooling down. Heading progressing across state. Some increase in weed pressure.

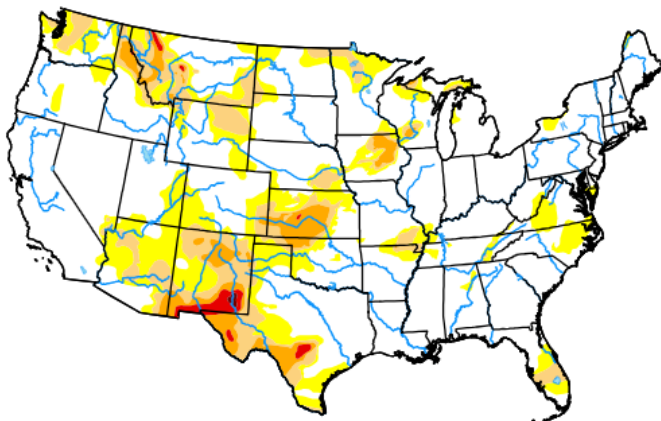

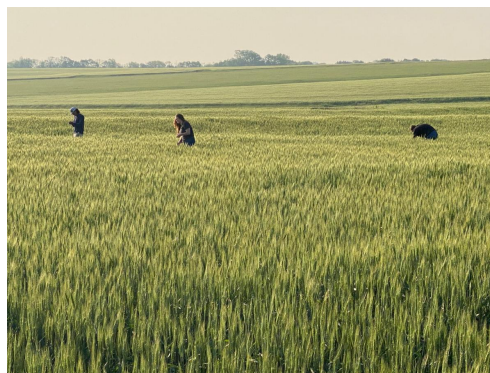
